Through Internal Road Strengthening Work

There is crucial Importance of road infrastructure development on the economic growth and competitiveness of any Industrial Estate. It was observed that Dahej Estate 1, 2 & 3 requires quality road network & we had received plenty of communications from member industries regarding the same, in particular Internal Roads.

In addition, we have analysed the need of road infrastructure in relation to competitiveness and Industrial investments inflow to the Dahej Industrial Estate. Outcome clearly indicates that, yes we should have strong & Charming Road Network across the estate.

As an action point we have jointly done exercise of identify required works for the Strengthening Road Network with GIDC. We have identified requirement of Strengthening work on 126

Kilometres of roads across the estate including Construction of New Bitumen & Rigid Pavement roads. We have given necessary consents to GIDC for executing required work & Entire work will be executed in phase wise & in manner that routine works of industries will not get disturb. At some locations work for the construction of Rigid Pavement Roads (RCC) is already get started

As far as budget part is concern, Industries of Dahej estate will be bear only 20% of project cost, for the rest of Budget part we have successfully convinced Government of Gujarat & Gujarat Industrial Development Corporation to share remaining 80% Expenditure of Project Cost.

And last but not least, all these work are assigned agencies with free maintenance Guarantee period of five years.
