Meeting of Local Crisis Group – Vagra

Key discussions emphasized regular safety audits, strict compliance with safety

regulations, conducting mock drills, improving coordination and information sharing, safe handling of hazardous chemical transportation, and avoiding part-load transport of hazardous materials.

Following the meeting, the SDM visited the Mini Emergency Response Centre to review the progress of the new building construction, reflecting the administration's proactive approach towards strengthening emergency response infrastructure.

Environment Clinic on XGN 2.0 & Winter Action Plan

The session focused on XGN 2.0 (new version of the XEN Portal) and the Winter Action Plan. Around 75 participants from industries of Dahej, Vilayat, and Saykha estates attended the clinic.

The dignitaries present included Shri S. N. Agravat, Unit Head – GPCB, Bharuch; Shri K. N. Vaghamsi, Regional Officer – GPCB, Bharuch; and Assistant Environmental Engineers from GPCB Head Office, Gandhinagar.

During the technical session, Shri K. N. Vaghamsi explained the application

procedures under XGN 2.0, key compliance requirements under the Winter Action Plan, and important aspects related to NGT matters. Shri S. N. Agravat highlighted GPCB's efforts to streamline regulatory processes and reduce application processing time to facilitate smoother clearances for industries.

An interactive Q&A session provided a constructive platform for dialogue between GPCB officials and industry representatives. The clinic concluded with a Vote of Thanks by Hon. General Secretary Shri Baldev Ahir.

Workshops, Seminars & Sessions

“Strengthening Industrial Safety: DIA–DISH Review on Accident Prevention”

Dahej Industries Association, in coordination with the Directorate of Industrial Safety and Health (DISH), organized a focused meeting on “Accident Prevention Action – Discussion and Review” at the DIA Conference Hall, Dahej. The meeting aimed at strengthening safety practices and enhancing proactive accident prevention measures across industries in the Dahej PCPIR region.

The meeting was attended by senior DISH officials including Mr. P.M. Shah (Director, DISH), Mr. R.A. Patel (Joint Director), Mr. D.B. Gamit and Mr. S.P. Pathak (Deputy Directors), Mr. V.A. Halvadiya (Assistant Director), and Mr. A.H. Meraiya (Industrial Safety & Health Officer), along with Dr. Sunil Bhatt, President, DIA, other office bearers, and senior representatives from member industries across the Dahej region.

Key Highlights:

Structured Safety Programs:

It was decided that DISH and DIA will jointly conduct one Safety Training Program every month and organize a Quarterly Safety Meeting, hosted by a major industry within the Dahej PCPIR. This initiative will ensure continuous learning and improved safety awareness across industries.

Strengthening Safety Culture:
Dr. Sunil Bhatt emphasized that regular

awareness and training programs are essential to reducing accident cases and building a strong safety culture within industrial operations.

Technical & Regulatory Focus:
The Director, DISH, Mr. P.M. Shah, highlighted critical compliance areas including:

- BIS standards implementation
- Equipment testing and pressure vessel safety
- Safety auditor rules
- Training and competency development
- Fall protection and emergency evacuation systems
- Industrial hygiene monitoring
- Clarification on the Working Hours Ordinance

An interactive open forum allowed industry members to raise queries, which were addressed by DISH authorities with detailed guidance.

The meeting concluded with a clear roadmap for collaborative action between DISH and DIA to promote continuous safety improvement, regulatory compliance, and proactive accident prevention across the Dahej industrial region. DIA remains committed to supporting member industries in achieving higher standards of safety and operational excellence.



Joint Training Programme on First Aid, Fire, Safety & Security

Dahej Industries Association, in joint association with the DISH Office, Bharuch and HSE Foundation, successfully organized a Basic Training Programme on First Aid, Fire, Safety & Security to enhance safety awareness and emergency preparedness among industrial personnel.

Representatives from various member industries of the Dahej Industrial Estate actively participated and benefited from the interactive sessions and expert insights.

Safety Officers' Meeting on "How to Prevent Accidents"

On the initiative of the Deputy Director, Industrial Safety and Health (DISH), Bharuch, a Safety Officers' Meeting on the theme "How to Prevent Accidents" was jointly organized with Dahej Industries Association (DIA) at the DIA Conference Hall on 10th September 2025.

The session was chaired by Shri D. B. Gamit, Deputy Director, Industrial Safety and Health, Bharuch, and attended by safety professionals from member industries across the Dahej region.

Mr. Dilip Patel, Safety Head, Neogen Chemicals Ltd., delivered a detailed presentation on safe Bromine handling, covering storage practices, process safety measures, spill response, health hazards and antidotes, PPE usage, SOPs, preventive maintenance, inspection systems, and statutory compliance requirements.

Mr. Rutvik Joshi of Happy Associates spoke on workplace monitoring and occupational health risks, including asbestosis, silicosis, pneumoconiosis, byssinosis, and occupational asthma. He emphasized monitoring of CMR chemicals, air sampling,

industrial hygiene assessments, and noise monitoring to safeguard employee health.

Mr. Somnath Sarkar, Safety Head, OPaL Dahej, shared best practices in HSE management, emergency preparedness systems, tactical firefighting training, advanced notification mechanisms, and the integration of AI & ML in fire and safety management.

A focused discussion followed, where Safety Officers deliberated on practical strategies for accident prevention.

Shri D. B. Gamit emphasized the importance of conducting such training programmes regularly and strengthening Mutual Aid Agreements among industries, along with effective mock drills for emergency preparedness.

The meeting witnessed active participation from 92 representatives and served as a valuable platform for knowledge sharing, safety awareness enhancement, and reinforcing the collective commitment to safer workplace practices in the Dahej industrial community.



Training Programme on “Safety for Working at Height

Dahej Industries Association, in association with Dahej Eco-Friendly Society (DEFS), organized a training programme on “*Safety for Working at Height*” on 26th August 2025 (Tuesday) at the Conference Hall, DIA.

The programme was conducted with the objective of educating industrial workers and safety personnel on best practices and precautionary measures while performing tasks at height, where the risk of fall-related accidents is significant.

The training covered critical aspects including fall prevention techniques, proper use of personal protective equipment (PPE), safe work procedures, legal and regulatory compliance, and emergency response and rescue systems

Special emphasis was placed on hazard identification, inspection of safety harnesses and lifelines, scaffolding safety, and adherence to statutory safety standards.

The session followed an interactive methodology comprising technical

presentations, group discussions, and practical demonstrations, encouraging active participation and real-time clarification of doubts.

A total of 53 participants from various member industries of the Dahej Industrial Estate attended the programme and actively engaged in the learning process

The programme was conducted under the provisions of Section 111(A) of the Factories Act, 1948, reinforcing the rights and responsibilities of workers in maintaining a safe working environment.

The training proved to be highly beneficial in strengthening safety awareness, improving compliance practices, and promoting accident prevention measures related to work at height.

DIA reaffirmed its commitment to organizing such focused safety initiatives to enhance workplace safety standards across the Dahej industrial community.

Activities for Safety & Disaster Management

State-Level Mock Drill at Dahej Industrial Estate

A large-scale State-Level Mock Drill on Chemical and Oil Disaster Management was successfully conducted on 21st November 2025 at the Dahej Industrial Estate. The exercise was organized by NDMA and GSDMA and coordinated by the District Administration, Bharuch.

The drill aimed to assess industrial emergency preparedness, response systems, and inter-agency coordination in the high-risk industrial zone.

At OPaL, a chemical leakage scenario was simulated to evaluate hazard containment, PPE usage, and emergency response effectiveness.

At Petronet LNG, a high-risk LNG and flammable material scenario tested area isolation, leak control, and adherence to safety protocols.

The exercise was conducted under the leadership of the District Collector & District Magistrate, Bharuch, with active participation from Fire & Emergency Services, Police, Health Department, DISH, and GPCB.

The drill ensured effective traffic control, emergency triage, firefighting operations, and containment measures.

Representatives of Dahej Industries Association observed the exercise and appreciated the coordinated efforts of industries and authorities.

The mock drill strengthened the Incident Response System of Bharuch district and reaffirmed that Dahej Industrial Estate is well-prepared to manage large-scale industrial emergencies, ensuring safety of personnel, environment, and industrial assets.

Fire Safety & Disaster Management Mock Drill

In collaboration with Dahej Police Station, Dahej Industries Association (DIA) and the Disaster Management Center conducted a practical Fire Safety & Disaster Management Mock Drill for Student Police Cadets (SPC) on 5th October 2025.

The programme was organized under the Suraksha Setu Society initiative during a one-day non-residential SPC camp, with active participation from students of Classes 8 and 9 from various schools in the Dahej area.

The initiative aimed to build awareness, discipline, and emergency preparedness among young cadets through hands-on training and live demonstrations.

To provide realistic exposure, DIA deployed its specialized Emergency Response Rescue Vehicle along with trained Fire & Safety professionals.

Students were briefed on immediate response actions during fire incidents and other emergencies to ensure personal and public safety.

Live demonstrations of Breathing Apparatus (BA) sets, personal protective equipment, and rescue tools gave insight into professional emergency operations.

A practical session on fire extinguisher usage using the PASS technique enabled students to understand safe fire control methods.

Rescue techniques in hazardous situations were also demonstrated, highlighting teamwork, alertness, and calm decision-making.

The programme concluded with an interactive session, reinforcing DIA's commitment to community safety and regional disaster preparedness.

ભરૂચ જિલ્લામાં જોખમી ઉધોગો આવેલાં છે ત્યારે બચાવ અને રાહત ટીમોની સતર્કતા તપાસવા માટે શુક્રવારના રોજ રાજ્યકક્ષાની મોકડ્રીલ યોજવામાં આવી હતી. દહેજની ઓપલ તથા એલએનજ પેટ્રોનેટ કંપની ખાતે આ મોકડ્રીલ યોજવામાં આવી હતી. નેશનલ ડિઝાસ્ટર મેનેજમેન્ટ ઓથોરિટી અને ગુજરાત સ્ટેટ ડિઝાસ્ટર મેનેજમેન્ટ ઓથોરિટી તથા જિલ્લા ક્રાઈસીસ ગ્રુપના સંયુક્ત ઉપક્રમે ત્રીજા સ્તરની મોકડ્રીલનું આયોજન કરાયું હતું. ઓપલમાં ટેન્કમાં સંપ્રહિત હેવી પ્રોપીલિનના લીકેજનેકારણે વિસ્ફોટ થયો અને આગ લાગી હતી. જ્યારે પેટ્રોનેટ એલએનજમાં 16 ઈંચની પાઈપલાઈનમાં ભંગાણ પડવાથી ફૂડ ઓઈલની પાઈપ લાઈનમાંથી ફૂડ લીકેજ થયું હતું. જે લીકેજના



કારણે આગ લાગી હતી. લેવલ 3 ની ઓફ સાઈટ ઈમરજન્સી જાહેર કરવામાં આવી હતી.ફાયર બ્રિગેડની ટીમ તેમના 18 વાહનો સાથે આગને કાબૂમાં લેવા ઘટના સ્થળે આવી પહોંચી હતી. મોકડ્રીલ દરમ્યાન ઘટનાની જાણ થતાં જિલ્લા કલેક્ટર ગૌરાંગ મકવાણાનીસુચનાથી નાયબ કલેક્ટર એમ.એન.મનાણી દહેજ ખાતે પહોંચી ગયા હતા.

દાંતા 1 : ઓપલમાં 10 વ્યક્તિઓને ઇજા પહોંચી

ઓપલમાં સ્ટેરીયલમાં સંપ્રહિત હેવી પ્રોપીલિનના લીકેજને 10 વ્યક્તિઓ ઈજાગ્રસ્ત થયાં હતાં જેમાંથી 2 વ્યક્તિઓને તાત્કાલિક સારવાર અર્થે ભરૂચ સિવિલમાં હોસ્પિટલમાં સ્થળાંતરકરવામાં આવ્યા હતા. તેની સાથે સ્થાનિક આરોગ્ય તંત્રની ડોક્ટર અને અન્ય આરોગ્ય ક્ષમિઓએ તમામની સારવાર કરી હતી આ ઘટના દરમ્યાન 9 જેટલા ફાયર વાહનો તાત્કાલિક ઘટના સ્થળે પહોંચીને આગને ઝડપથી કાબૂમાં લેવા તજવીજ હાથ ધરવામાં આવી હતી.

દાંતા 2 : પેટ્રોનેટમાં ભંગાણથી આગ લાગી

પેટ્રોનેટ ખાતે 16 ઈંચની પાઈપલાઈનમાં ભંગાણપડવાથી લિકેજ થયેલ કેમિકલમાં અચાનક લાગેલ આગ અંગેની મોકડ્રીલ યોજવામાં આવી હતી.મોકડ્રીલમાં એન.ડીઆરએફ અને સ્થાનિક તંત્રના સહયોગથી 222વ્યક્તિઓનું રેસ્ક્યુ કરવામાં આવ્યું હતું. જેમાંથી 4 લોકો વધુ ઈજાગ્રસ્ત હોવાથી તેમને તાત્કાલિક સારવાર અર્થે ખેડડવામાં આવ્યા હતા. નજીકના પી.એચ.સી. સેન્ટર ખાતે બેડની હોસ્પિટલ ઉભી કરી દેવામાં આવી હતી.

ભરૂચમાં રાજ્યકક્ષાની ઓઈલ-કેમિકલ ડિઝાસ્ટર મોકડ્રિલ યોજાઈ: ઓપલ ONGC દહેજ અને પેટ્રોનેટ LNGમાં સજ્જતા ચકાસાઈ

(પ્રતિનિધિ)ભરૂચ,તા.૨૧ કરવામાં આવી હતી. સિમ્યુલેશન ઘટના ઉભી ભરૂચ જિલ્લામાં શુક્રવારે ઘટનામાં ૧૦ લોકો ઈજાગ્રસ્ત કરવામાં આવી હતી. દહેજ GIDC વિસ્તારમાં થયા હોવાની પરિસ્થિતિ ઘટનાની જાણ થતાં લેવલ-૩ આવેલી ઓપલ ONGC તૈયાર કરવામાં આવી હતી ઈમરજન્સી જાહેર કરવામાં દહેજ અને પેટ્રોનેટ LNG જેમાંથી ૨ને તાત્કાલિક ભરૂચ આવી હતી. NDRF અને કંપનીઓ ખાતે રાજ્યકક્ષાની સિવિલ હોસ્પિટલ ખસેડવામાં ઓઈલ એન્ડ કેમિકલ ડિઝાસ્ટર આવાયા હતા. ફાયર વિભાગના અભિયાન દ્વારા કુલ ૨૨૨ મોકડ્રિલ યોજાઈ હતી. ૮ વાહનો ઘટનાસ્થળે પહોંચીને લોકોનું રેસ્ક્યુ કરવામાં આવ્યું NDMA, GSDMA અને આગ કાબુમાં લેવાની કામગીરી હતું. તેમાંમાંથી ૪ લોકો જિલ્લા વહીવટીતંત્રના સંયુક્ત કરતાં પોલીસ દ્વારા ગંભીર ઈજાગ્રસ્ત હોવાની ઉપક્રમે યોજાયેલી આ વાહનવ્યવહારનું નિયંત્રણ પરિસ્થિતિમાં તેમને તાત્કાલિક મોકડ્રિલનો હેતુ ત્રીજા લેવલની સંભાળાયું હતું. આરોગ્ય તંત્રે સારવાર માટે ખસેડાયા હતા. ઈમરજન્સી પરિસ્થિતિ વખતે તમામ ઈજાગ્રસ્તોની આરોગ્ય આરોગ્ય વિભાગે નજીકના તંત્રોની સજ્જતા અને સંકલન તપાસ કરી હતી. PHC ખાતે બેડેડની સુવિધા ઉભી કરી હતી. ફાયર કોસ્ટગાર્ડની ટીમોએ પણ ક્ષમતા ચકાસવાનો હતો. પેટ્રોનેટ LNG ખાતે ભૂકંપના કારણે વિભાગના ૧૮ વાહનો આગ કાબૂમાં લેવા પહોંચી ગયા હતા, જ્યારે પોલીસ અને કોસ્ટગાર્ડની ટીમોએ પણ

કામગીરીમાં સહકાર આપ્યો પરિસ્થિતિનું માર્ગદર્શન આપ્યું હતો. મોકડ્રિલની જાણ થતા મોકડ્રિલ બાદ તંત્રોની જિલ્લા કલેક્ટર ગૌરાંગ કામગીરીની સમીક્ષા બેઠક યોજાઈ હતી જેમાં NDMA અને GSDMAના અધિકારીઓએ કામગીરીની પ્રશંસા સાથે નાની-મોટી ખામીઓ અંગે ચર્ચા કરી હતી.

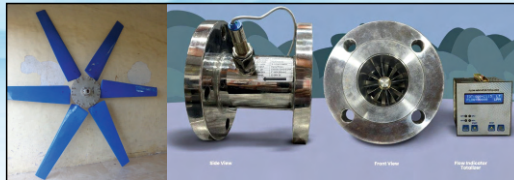
