This edition of *Uttkarsh* captures these impactful developments, along with glimpses of ongoing association activities and updates from member industries. We have also documented valuable learnings from visiting delegations and collaborative sessions.

We take this opportunity to thank all our members for their continued trust, proactive engagement, and unwavering support. Together, let us continue to shape Dahej into a global benchmark for industrial excellence.

Environmental Activities

Tree Plantation Drive on World Environment Day

Session on Understanding and Implementing EPR for Plastic Waste

As part of its ongoing efforts to assist industries in understanding evolving environmental regulations, Dahej Industries Association (DIA), in collaboration with Nepra Environmental Solutions Technologies Pvt. Ltd. (NEST), organized an informative session on “Understanding and Implementing Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) for Plastic Waste” on 3rd January 2025 at the Conference Hall, DIA.

The session aimed to provide practical guidance to industries on complying with the Plastic Waste Management Rules, with special emphasis on the EPR framework, which is rapidly becoming a regulatory and operational priority for industrial units.

The session was led by Ms. Renuka Udare, Senior Project Coordinator – Advisory, NEST. With her extensive expertise in waste management, EPR mechanisms, and policy interpretation, she shared valuable insights into the legal, procedural, and practical aspects of EPR implementation for producers, brand owners, and recyclers.

❖ Key Topics Covered:

- Overview of Plastic Waste Management Rules – An outline of legal provisions, recent amendments, and responsibilities for industries.
- Understanding EPR Guidelines – Explanation of EPR targets, CPCB portal registration process, and compliance obligations.
- Environmental Compensation (EC) – Details of non-compliance penalties and strategies for industries to mitigate legal risks. Challenges and Solutions – Discussion on industry-specific challenges in EPR execution and practical solutions for smoother implementation.

The session proved to be highly relevant and informative for member industries. It enabled participants to better understand their roles and responsibilities under the EPR guidelines and offered clarity on compliance requirements to avoid penalties and legal complications.



Civil Defence Training Program at Vagra Taluka Panchayat

- Successful Closure: The drill concluded at 8:00 PM with a final siren, marking the end of a well-coordinated and efficient mock drill exercise.

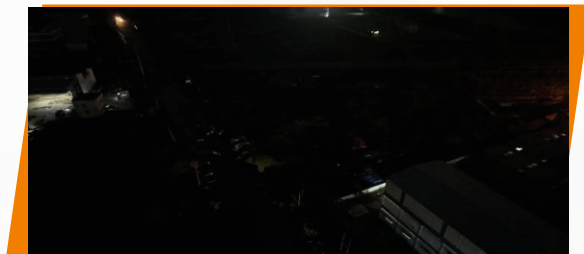
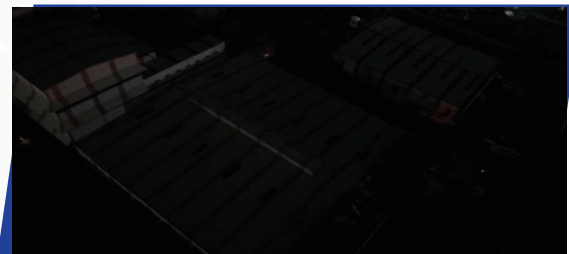

Visit of GIDC VCMD at Dahej Industrial Estate

1. Infrastructure Development

- Continued focus on road development with the support of government subsidies.
- Updates on the proposed Transport Nagars for both Dahej-1 and Dahej-2.
- Strategic planning of a PCPIR escape route to strengthen emergency preparedness.
- Review of progress on the Control and Command Center, modeled on the Sanand Estate facility.

2. Estate Amenities & Services

- A dedicated plot in the D-2/3 Estate was proposed for setting up a Mini Emergency Response Center (ERC).

- Proposal for a 300-bed hospital with an integrated Nursing College to enhance healthcare infrastructure.
- Proposal for the allocation of land for a Sports Complex to support community well-being.
- Plans to upgrade the CETP in line with updated environmental norms.

3. Land & Development

- Request to fast-track the Kesarol land acquisition for the proposed industrial housing colony.
- Proposal to transfer the Atali Housing commercial plot at concessional rates to support social infrastructure.
- Request for extension of plot utilization timelines until March 2026, subject to applicable Non-Utilization (NU) charges.

DIA remains committed to collaborating with GIDC and other authorities to accelerate infrastructure growth, promote industrial excellence, and ensure sustainable development across the Dahej region.



Meeting with Hon'ble Union Minister Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya

On 21st February 2025, the President and Hon. General Secretary of Dahej Industries Association had a courtesy visit with Hon'ble Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya, Union Minister of Labour & Employment and Minister of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India, in New Delhi.

The purpose of the meeting was to brief the Hon'ble Minister on the current industrial development and infrastructure requirements of Dahej Industrial Estate. Key discussions included the progress of ongoing GIDC upgradation projects in the estate and the development of the Bharuch–Dahej Road, which is crucial for improving connectivity and logistics in the region.

In addition, several proposals requiring support from the Government of India were presented, such as:

- Setting up of an ESIC Hospital and a General Government Hospital
- Establishment of a Convention Centre and a Sports Complex
- Development of a Skill Excellence Center
- Construction of Common Labour Accommodations
- Proposal for an Airstrip for both passenger and cargo purposes

The meeting was extremely positive and encouraging. Hon'ble Minister Dr. Mandaviya appreciated the proactive role of the Association and assured full cooperation and support from the central government for the long-term growth and holistic development of the Dahej industrial region.



Visit of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Gujarat to Dahej Estate

On 29th March 2025, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Gujarat visited Dahej Industrial Estate to review critical infrastructure projects and interact with the industrial community.

During the visit, the Hon'ble CM inspected major on-ground projects, including:

- The Bhaddbhat Barrage Project
- The newly constructed reservoir at Plot No. 93 The 90 MLD Deep Sea Discharge Pumping Station, targeted for completion by October 2025

On this occasion, the DIA submitted a detailed set of strategic proposals aimed at enhancing infrastructure, safety, and sustainability within the estate. Key proposals included:

- RCC road expansion, with a request for 80:20 government grant support
- Establishment of fire stations, a Transport Nagar, and a hazardous waste management facility

- A proposed 500-bed multi-specialty hospital along with a nursing college
- Development of an emergency escape route and expedited completion of the Bharuch–Dahej road
- Creation of housing clusters in Atali and Kesarol
- Establishment of a Command & Control Center based on the Sanand model
- Upgradation of the CETP and environmental infrastructure improvements
- Introduction of a dedicated electric bus service and a proposed Dahej–Bharuch metro line

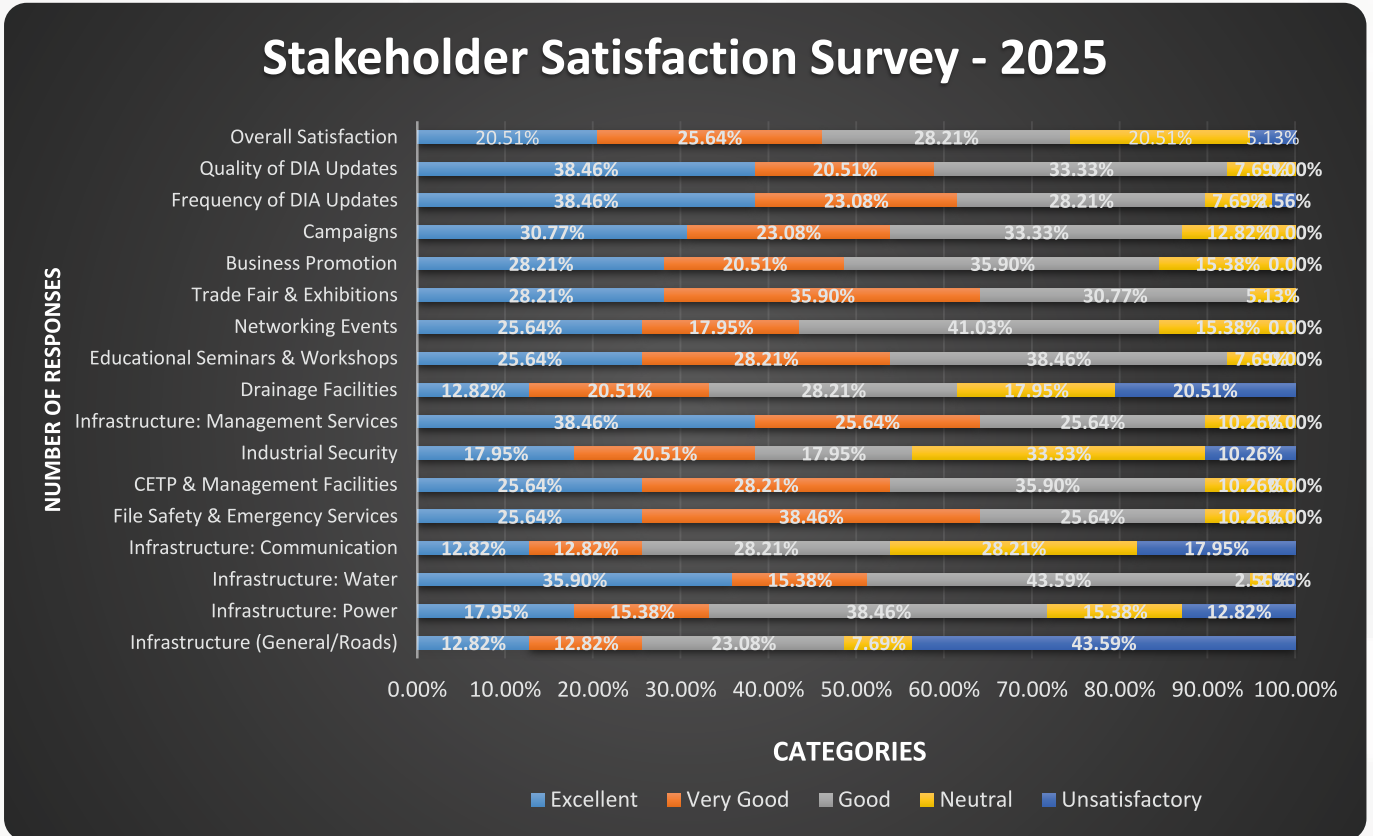

Areas for Improvement (Suggestions for Growth)

We are committed to continuous improvement, and your constructive suggestions are essential in helping us move forward. The following key areas have been identified for enhancement:

- **Road Infrastructure & Traffic Management:** Frequently highlighted concerns included the need for better road conditions, increased traffic police presence, and improved traffic systems—especially for heavy vehicles. Suggestions included implementing “No Entry” zones during peak hours and upgrading internal estate roads.
- **Power Supply Issues:** Multiple members raised concerns about power supply, voltage fluctuations, and frequent disturbances, urging significant improvements in this area.
- **Drainage Facility:** Few of the respondents the need for more efficient drainage facility for the storm water drainage.
- **Security Focus:** Several respondents emphasized the need for stronger industrial security measures.
- **Medical Facilities:** There was a clear call for better medical infrastructure and emergency health services in the Dahej region, especially Hospitals for emergency.
- **Mobile Network Connectivity:** Improving mobile signal and data connectivity was identified as an important need.
- **Housekeeping & Environment:** Members expressed concerns about inadequate housekeeping and cleanliness, especially of internal roads and public spaces.
- **Streetlighting:** The need for better streetlighting and the installation of hooded or directed lights was also mentioned.

Your feedback is invaluable, and we are already working on actionable plans to address these concerns. We will keep you updated on our progress and new initiatives aimed at improving the industrial ecosystem in Dahej.
